## Requirements

### Chiropractors (DC/ Cand. manu)

Complete Module 1 (lower extremity hands-on) and Module 2 (upper extremity hands-on). Complete the FICS video program (27 CD-ROMs incl. lectures and notes). Make a case study article or poster presentation or prove practical experience. Pass a written exam. Verification of current CPR or similar credentials in emergency procedures.

### Chiropractors with a CCSP

Completion of either Module 1 (lower extremity hands-on) and Module 2 (upper extremity hands-on). Present a case study article, published peer review literature or poster presentation or prove practical experience. Verification of current CPR or similar credentials in emergency procedures. NO video/CD program required.

### Chiropractor with DACBSP/CCSS (CAN), MSc, PhD or equivalent

Present a case study article, published peer review literature or poster presentation or proof of practical experience. Verification of current CPR or similar credentials in emergency procedures. NO video/CD program required.

*It is not required to obtain an ICSSD or to be interested in sports chiropractic alone to attend any ICSSD Modules as there will be relevant information offered for general chiropractic practice as well.*
